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PROJECT OVERVIEW

Alaska's integrated natural gas infrastructure and liquefied natural gas (LNG) export project is a world-class facility designed to maximize the value of Alaska's vast North Slope natural gas resources. The project includes a liquefaction facility in Nikiski, an 800-mile pipeline, and a gas treatment plant located in Prudhoe Bay. Alaska Gasline Development Corporation is leading the project on behalf of the State of Alaska.



LONG-TERM ENERGY SUPPLY

The purpose of the project is to bring gas to Alaskans. The project will ensure Alaskans have access to a long-term and affordable gas supply to support personal heating and electricity needs for generations.



IN-STATE GAS ACCESS

Multiple gas interconnection points along the pipeline route will allow for natural gas delivery to local markets. The location and size of the interconnection points are still being evaluated.



ECONOMIC GROWTH AND JOBS

Economic impact studies indicate the project will benefit Alaskans through royalties and jobs, and provide low-cost, clean energy to help stimulate economic activity throughout the state. The project will create up to 12,000 jobs during construction and approximately 1,000 jobs during operation. Numerous opportunities for Alaska businesses and contractors will also be created.
