FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: WILL ALASKANS HAVE ACCESS TO THE GAS DEVELOPED BY THE PROJECT?

A: One of the main purposes of the project is to bring gas to Alaskans. Multiple interconnection points along the pipeline will allow for in-state natural gas delivery. The location and size of the interconnection points is still being evaluated.

Q: WHY DO WE NEED INVESTORS AND CUSTOMERS TO BUILD THE PROJECT?

A: The State is not financing the project on its own, therefore third party investors and customers are needed to fund or support funding for the project. AGDC is structuring the project to be attractive to investors and customers.

Q: WHAT IF WE WAIT TO BUILD THE GASLINE?

A: Delays in the project would reduce the potential to monetize Alaska's vast natural gas resource for the foreseeable future. There are numerous LNG projects around the world competing to serve the LNG demand. If we wait, the demand will be supplied by existing or new suppliers, and Alaska will be left behind.

Q: WHAT BENEFITS DOES THE PROJECT PROVIDE TO THE STATE OF ALASKA?

A: The project will benefit Alaskans through royalties and jobs, and by providing low-cost, clean energy to help stimulate economic activity throughout the state. The project will create up to 12,000 jobs during construction and approximately 1,000 jobs during operation.

Q: WHAT CAN ALASKANS DO TO HELP SUPPORT THE PROJECT?

A: Alaskans can support the project by staying informed and communicating their support to their representatives. The project will help encourage development of Alaska's vast North Slope gas resource, provide reliable and competitive fuel to mining and other industrial projects in the state, provide natural gas to numerous in-state markets, increase Alaska's foreign trade, and provide a quality employment base for virtually all Alaska crafts and trades.
