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BIDEN ADMINISTRATION REPORT CONFIRMS ALASKA LNG ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS

ANCHORAGE, AK (Jan. 10) – The Biden Administration Department of Energy (DOE) has published the final Supplemental Impact Statement (SEIS) for the Alaska LNG Project. The final SEIS generally confirms the conclusions of the draft SEIS, published in June 2022.

The Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) is developing Alaska LNG under a mandate from the Alaska Legislature to commercialize Alaska’s North Slope natural gas for the benefit of Alaskans. Nothing in the DOE SEIS appears to impact DOE’s existing export authorization. DOE will issue a record of decision in the Spring of 2023.
